- Supports ongoing training of field organizers
- Coordinate with project leadership to ensure alignment with project goals and timelines.
- Submit weekly progress reports to the TC4 project manager.
- Analyze data and provide regular reports on progress and challenges.
- Represent Empower Missouri and regional Tenant Unions at community events and meetings as needed.

- Ability to work independently and as part of a team.
