

FUNDRAISING INTERN

PURPOSE

The Fundraising Intern will assist the Development Manager with the organization's efforts to secure funding, cultivate relationships with donors, and enhance our overall development processes.

The Fundraising Intern will work independently and with a team to support Empower Missouri's fundraising efforts through research, data management, communications, and logistical assistance. This role provides a solid foundation for a career in nonprofit development.

POTENTIAL DUTIES & RESPONSIBILITIES

- **Communications:** Draft correspondence, newsletters, and other fundraising materials. Track donor milestones; support acknowledgement processes.
- Data & Reporting: Compile data and generate reports.
- **Event Support:** Provide support for fundraising events through research and prospecting of venues and in kind donations
- **Research:** Investigate new fundraising initiatives, corporate giving trends, and potential corporate sponsorships. Research potential grant opportunities as assigned by the Development Manager.

REQUIREMENTS

- A strong interest and/or experience in development/fundraising work. Students in their 3rd or 4th year of a program in communications, marketing, nonprofit management, or a related major will be a good fit.
- A commitment to social justice + <u>Empower Missouri's mission and values</u>
- Exceptional written and verbal communication skills
- Strong research, analytical, and organizational abilities
- Experience with donor database software a plus
