- Communities working on or interested in issues related to food access, hunger and health, food and farm business development or other food system opportunities are encouraged to participate.
- Priority will be given to communities/projects located in rural counties or part of a rural-urban regional partnership.

HOW TO APPLY

Two communities will be selected annually 2024-2026 to collaborate with MU Extension and the Missouri Rural Food Access Partnership grant team to conduct a Missouri EATs community planning process.
